1.6	Section 1. [237.122] PERSONAL INFORMATION; PROHIBITION.
1.7	A telecommunications or Internet service provider that has entered into a franchise
1.8	agreement, right-of-way agreement, or other contract with the state of Minnesota or a
1.9	political subdivision, or that uses facilities that are subject to a franchise agreement,
1.10	right-of-way agreement, or other contract with the state of Minnesota or a political
1.11	subdivision even if the telecommunications or Internet services provider is not a party to
1.12	the agreement, is prohibited from collecting personal information from a customer resulting
1.13	from the customer's use of the telecommunications or Internet service provider without
1.14	express written approval from the customer. A telecommunications or Internet service
1.15	provider is prohibited from refusing to provide service to a customer on the grounds that
1.16	the customer has not approved collection of the customer's personal information.
