- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to state lands; authorizing conveyance of certain tax-forfeited land.
- 1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.4 Section 1. **CONVEYANCE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND; SHERBURNE COUNTY.**
- 1.5 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 282.01, subdivision 1a, and the public
- 1.6 sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282, Sherburne County may convey to the
- 1.7 city of Big Lake for no consideration the tax-forfeited land described in paragraph (c).
- 1.8 (b) The land must be conveyed in fee title, subject only to the reservation of mineral
- 1.9 rights to the state. The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The
- 1.10 attorney general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure
- 1.11 accuracy.
- 1.12 (c) The land to be conveyed is located in Sherburne County and is described as: Outlot
- 1.13 A, Habitat 1st Addition, Section 30, Township 33, Range 27 (parcel identification
- 1.14 65-451-0010).
- 1.15 (d) The county has determined that the land is needed by the city of Big Lake to store
- 1.16 drainage of surface water and for future use as a park.
- 1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
