OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; insurance; requiring coverage for ectodermal dysplasia; proposing
1.3 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. 62A.3096 **COVERAGE FOR ECTODERMAL DYSPLASIA.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section "ectodermal dysplasia" means a
1.7 genetic disorder involving the absence or deficiency of tissues and structures derived from
1.8 the embryonic ectoderm.

1.9 Subd. 2. Coverage. A health plan must include coverage for treatment of ectodermal
1.10 dysplasia.

1.11 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2019, and applies to health
1.12 plans offered, issued, or sold on or after that date.
