1.7	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 137.0245, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.8	Subd. 2. Membership. The Regent Candidate Advisory Council shall consist of 24 20
1.9	members. Twelve members shall be appointed by the Subcommittee on Committees of the
1.10	Committee on Rules and Administration of the senate. Twelve members shall be appointed
1.11	by the speaker of the house. Each appointing authority must appoint one member who is a
1.12	student enrolled in a degree program at the University of Minnesota at the time of
1.13	appointment. No more than one-third of the members appointed by each appointing authority
1.14	may be current or former legislators. No more than two-thirds of the members appointed
1.15	by each appointing authority may belong to the same political party; however, political
1.16	activity or affiliation is not required for the appointment of any member. The speaker of
1.17	the house, house minority leader, senate majority leader, and senate minority leader shall
1.18	each appoint four members as follows:
1.19	(1) three members who have no prior experience as a legislator or regent; and
1.20	(2) one member serving as a legislator at the time of appointment.
1.21	The Board of Regents shall appoint one member who is serving as a regent at the time
1.22	of appointment.
