1.5	Section 1. [145.417] ABORTION PROHIBITED WHEN FETAL HEARTBEAT
1.6	DETECTED.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Definitions. (a) The definitions in this subdivision apply to this section.
1.8	(b) "Abortion" means the use or prescription of any instrument, medicine, drug, or other
1.9	substance or device to intentionally terminate the pregnancy of a woman known to be
1.10	pregnant, with an intention other than to increase the probability of a live birth, preserve
1.11	the life or health of the child after birth, or remove a dead fetus.
1.12	(c) "Fetal heartbeat" means the steady and repetitive rhythmic contraction of the fetal
1.13	heart within the gestational sac.
1.14	(d) "Medical emergency" means any condition that, on the basis of the physician's good
1.15	faith clinical judgment, so complicates the condition of the pregnant woman as to necessitate
1.16	the immediate abortion of her pregnancy to avert her death or for which a delay creates a
1.17	serious risk of substantial and irreversible impairment of a major bodily function.
1.18	(e) "Physician" means a person licensed as a physician or osteopathic physician under
1.19	chapter 147.
1.20	(f) "Unborn child" means a member of the species Homo sapiens from fertilization until
1.21	birth.
