1.6	Subdivision 1. Sugar beet-hauling vehicles. A road authority may issue a permit for a
1.7	vehicle that transports sugar beets and meets the following requirements:
1.8	(1) is a combination of vehicles, including a truck-tractor and a semitrailer drawing one
1.9	additional semitrailer, and no semitrailer used in the three-vehicle combination has an overall
1.10	length in excess of 28-1/2 feet;
1.11	(2) does not exceed a maximum gross vehicle weight of 129,000 pounds; and
