OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to insurance; requiring disclosure of whether money from a patient
1.3 assistance program is applied to a health plan deductible; proposing coding for
1.4 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62Q.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[62Q.524] DISCLOSURE OF APPLICATION OF FUNDS FROM A**
1.7 **PATIENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO A DEDUCTIBLE.**

1.8 A health plan company must include in the summary of benefits and coverage a statement
1.9 that indicates whether the health plan company applied money from a patient assistance
1.10 program, as defined in section 62J.84, subdivision 2, paragraph (h), to an enrollee's
1.11 deductible.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2024, and applies to health
1.13 plans offered, issued, or renewed on or after that date.
