1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to corrections; directing the commissioner of corrections to issue a grant
1.3 to a qualified nongovernmental organization to assist inmates in finding meaningful
1.4 employment after release from incarceration; appropriating money.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **POSTRELEASE EMPLOYMENT FOR INMATES; REQUEST FOR**
1.7 **PROPOSALS; GRANT.**

1.8 (a) By September 1, 2022, the commissioner of corrections must issue a request for
1.9 proposals to identify a nongovernmental organization to provide curriculum and corporate
1.10 mentors to inmates and assist inmates in finding meaningful employment upon release from
1.11 a correctional facility.

1.12 (b) An interested organization must submit an application to the commissioner on a form
1.13 prescribed by the commissioner.

1.14 (c) By December 1, 2022, the commissioner shall award a \$1,000,000 grant to the
1.15 applicant that is best qualified to provide the programming described in paragraph (a).

1.16 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION; POSTRELEASE EMPLOYMENT FOR INMATES.**

1.17 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.18 of corrections for the purpose of section 1.
