1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SAFETY PROGRAM FOR WATERCRAFT
1.6	OPERATORS; APPROPRIATION.
1.7	(a) The commissioner of natural resources, in consultation with interested parties, must
1.8	develop recommendations for establishing a safety program for watercraft operators. The
1.9	program must include:
1.10	(1) requirements that a person complete and pass a watercraft safety course designed by
1.11	the commissioner in order to operate certain motorized watercraft over 16 feet;
1.12	(2) a watercraft safety course that covers the following topics:
1.13	(i) watercraft safety;
1.14	(ii) best practices to reduce conflicts with other water resource users;
1.15	(iii) ecological impacts of watercraft; and
1.16	(iv) aquatic invasive species prevention;
1.17	(3) an endorsement that is required for a watercraft operator to operate a watercraft with
1.18	enhanced wake technology and that requires completing and passing an additional course.

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- 2.1 (i) recommendations of the Minnesota Aquatic Invasive Species Research Center for
- 2.2 reducing the risk of spreading aquatic invasive species by watercraft with enhanced wake
- 2.3 <u>technology and mitigating other negative impacts of the watercraft; and</u>
- 2.4 (ii) research of the St. Anthony Falls Laboratory on the dynamics of enhanced wakes
- 2.5 and the impacts to lake sediments and aquatic plants; and
- 2.6 (4) an optional endorsement for a watercraft operator to become certified as an aquatic
- 2.7 <u>invasive species self-inspector, allowing the watercraft operator to serve as an aquatic</u>
- 2.8 <u>invasive species ambassador at special events and boat ramps and bypass certain inspection</u>
