1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 148E.240, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 6. **Duty to warn.** (a) A licensee must comply with the duty to warn established
1.8 by section 148.975.

1.9 (b) For purposes of this subdivision, "licensee" includes interns and students.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
