OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to public safety; amending the definition of prior qualified human  
1.3 trafficking-related offense to include violations of certain state laws committed in  
1.4 the person's lifetime and violations of similar laws in other states; amending  
1.5 Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.321, subdivision 14.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.321, subdivision 14, is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 14. **Prior qualified human trafficking-related offense.** A "prior qualified human  
1.9 trafficking-related offense" means a previous conviction or delinquency adjudication ~~within~~  
1.10 ~~the ten years from the discharge from probation or parole immediately preceding the current~~  
1.11 ~~offense~~ for a violation of or an attempt to violate section 609.322, subdivision 1 (solicitation,  
1.12 inducement, and promotion of prostitution; sex trafficking in the first degree); 609.322,  
1.13 subdivision 1a (solicitation, inducement, and promotion of prostitution; sex trafficking in  
1.14 the second degree); 609.282 (labor trafficking); ~~or~~ 609.283 (unlawful conduct with respect  
1.15 to documents in furtherance of labor or sex trafficking); or a statute from another state or  
1.16 the United States in conformity with any of these offenses.

1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2024, and applies to crimes  
1.18 committed on or after that date.
