1.5	Section 1. COLLABORATIVE SUMMER INTENSIVE PROGRAM.
1.6	An intensive summer school program for students in grades 5 through 8 is established
1.7	in six school districts. The school districts of Ely, Independent School District No. 696; St.
1.8	Louis County, Independent School District No. 2142; Mesabi East, Independent School
1.9	District No. 2711; Mountain Iron-Buhl, Independent School District No. 712; Chisholm,
1.10	Independent School District No. 695; and Hibbing, Independent School District No. 701;
1.11	must collaborate to provide a summer school program that includes vocational, academic,
