1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. NORTHWEST REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation; bond proceeds. (a) \$26,840,000 is appropriated from
1.8	the bond proceeds fund to the Pollution Control Agency for grants to nine counties to fund
1.9	specified aspects of a regional waste management system that will include two new lined
1.10	regional debris disposal facilities located in Hubbard and Polk Counties; 12 mixed-use
1.11	collection and processing facilities, one each located in the counties of Beltrami, Cass,
1.12	Clearwater, Hubbard, Mahnomen, Marshall, Norman, Polk, and Red Lake, that coordinate
1.13	with the two regional debris disposal facilities; upgrades to a regional organics composting
1.14	facility in Polk County; and the acquisition and installation of robots in a regional recycling
1.15	facility in Polk County. Of this appropriation:
1.16	(1) \$3,935,000 is for a grant to Beltrami County to design and construct new buildings
1.17	and site improvements at the existing solid waste processing facility in Beltrami County
1.18	and to acquire and install capital equipment;
1.19	(2) \$5,103,000 is for a grant to Cass County to design and construct new buildings and
1.20	make site improvements at the existing solid waste processing facility in Cass County, and
1.21	to acquire and install capital equipment;
