| 1.8 | (a) A person may be evicted if the person has unlawfully or forcibly occupied or taken |
| 1.9 | possession of real property or unlawfully detains or retains possession of real property. |
| 1.10 | (b) An individual who is not renting a residential rental unit, and who is not on the lease |
| 1.11 | and does not have a contract or sublease to reside in the rental unit, does not need to be |
| 1.12 | evicted to be removed from a property or dwelling. An individual may be removed for |
| 1.13 | trespass, or arrested for trespass consistent with section 609.605, if the individual: |
| 1.14 | (1) does not have a signed lease for the residential rental unit, or the individual does not |
