1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; appropriating money for housing needs.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS.

1.5 (a) \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated
1.6 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the long-term homeless
1.7 supportive services fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 256K.26.

1.8 (b) \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated
1.9 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a housing with supports
1.10 for adults with serious mental illness grant program, which is a grant program for housing
1.11 developers, county mental health authorities, and tribes to increase supportive housing
1.12 options.

1.13 (c) \$500,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from
1.14 the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the transitional housing program
1.15 under Minnesota Statutes, section 256E.33.

1.16 (d) \$250,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$250,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from
1.17 the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the emergency services program,
1.18 which provides services and emergency shelter for homeless Minnesotans under Minnesota
1.19 Statutes, section 256E.36.
