1.7	Section 1. [136A.901] SPINAL CORD INJURY AND TRAUMATIC BRAIN
1.8	INJURY RESEARCH GRANT PROGRAM.
1.9	Subdivision 1. Grant program. The commissioner shall establish a grant program
1.10	to award grants to institutions in Minnesota for research into spinal cord injuries and
1.11	traumatic brain injuries. Grants shall be awarded to conduct research into new and
1.12	innovative treatments and rehabilitative efforts for the functional improvement of people
1.13	with spinal cord and traumatic brain injuries. Research topics may include, but are not
1.14	limited to, pharmaceutical, medical device, brain stimulus, and rehabilitative approaches
1.15	and techniques. The commissioner, in consultation with the advisory council established
1.16	under section 136A.907, shall award 40 percent of the grant funds for research involving
1.17	spinal cord injuries, 40 percent to research involving traumatic brain injuries, and 20
1.18	percent to the small business grant and loan program established in subdivision 2.

1.20	grants and loans to small businesses conducting research on innovative treatments and

3.4	Subd. 4. Terms of initial council members. The commissioner shall designate six
3.5	of the initial council members to serve one-year terms and six to serve two-year terms.
3.6	Subd. 5. Conflict of interest. Council members must disclose in a written statement
3.7	any financial interest in any organization that the council recommends to receive a grant.
3.8	The written statement must accompany the grant recommendations and must explain
3.9	the nature of the conflict.
3.10	Subd. 6. Duties. The advisory council shall:
3.11	(1) develop criteria for evaluating and awarding the research grants under section
3.12	<u>136A.901;</u>
3.13	(2) review research proposals and make recommendations by January 15 of each
3.14	year to the commissioner for purposes of awarding grants under section 136A.901; and
3.15	(3) perform other duties as authorized by the commissioner.
3.16	Subd. 7. Staffing. The commissioner shall provide administrative support to the
