1.11 level B intermediate care facilities for persons with developmental disabilities (ICF's/MR)

- 1.12 to replace a 15-bed level A facility in Minneapolis that is not accessible to persons with
- 1.13 disabilities. The new facilities must be accessible to persons with disabilities and must
- 1.14 be located on a different site or sites in Hennepin County. Notwithstanding section
- 1.15 256B.5012, the payment rate at the new facilities is \$200.47 plus any rate adjustments for
- 1.16 ICF's/MR effective on or after July 1, 2007.
