| 1.9 | individual 65 years of age or older is receiving personal assistance from the same agency |
| 1.10 | continuously during the six months prior to being newly enrolled with any managed care |
| 1.11 | or county-based purchasing plan, the managed care plan or county-based purchasing plan |
| 1.12 | with which the individual is newly enrolled must offer the agency a contract for the purposes |
| 1.13 | of allowing the enrollee to receive any personal assistance covered under the terms of the |
| 1.14 | plan from the enrollee's current agency, provided the enrollee continues to live in the service |
