1.3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.4	Section 1. SHORT-CALL SUBSTITUTE TEACHER PILOT.
1.5	(a) A school district may employ a person who meets the professional requirements of
1.6	Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.181, subdivision 2, paragraph (b), as a short-call substitute
1.7	teacher in any content area, not only career and technical education, notwithstanding any
1.8	licensing requirements in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 122A. A school district must request
1.9	a background check in accordance with section 123B.03 on a short-call substitute teacher
1.10	employed under this section. Each assignment to replace a teacher of record must last no
1.11	longer than 15 consecutive school days.
1.12	(b) A district must report to the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board
1.13	all persons it employs under this section and affirm that each person meets the professional
1.14	requirements for a short-call substitute teacher.
1.15	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for the 2020-2021, 2021-2022, and
1.16	2022-2023 school years only.
