1.5	Section 1. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED.
1.6	An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment
1.7	is adopted, a section shall be added to article I, to read:
1.8	Sec. 18. A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right
1.9	of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed.
