- (2) Conducts or attempts to conduct a [eurrency] <u>financial</u> transaction with the purpose to conceal or disguise in whole or in part the nature, location, source, ownership or control of the proceeds of criminal activity; or
 - (3) Conducts or attempts to conduct a [currency] <u>financial</u> transaction with the purpose to avoid [currency] <u>financial</u> transaction reporting requirements under federal law; or
 - (4) Conducts or attempts to conduct a [eurrency] financial transaction with the purpose to promote or aid the carrying on of criminal activity for the purpose of furthering or making a terrorist threat or act.
