

HB 1000 -- TRANSFER OF COURSE CREDIT

SPONSOR: West

This bill requires public institutions of higher education to accept equivalent core curriculum courses approved by the Coordinating Board for Higher Education per Section 178.786, RSMo., from "proprietary schools" as those schools are defined in Section 173.600.

If a student successfully completes all of the approved courses in the proprietary school's core curriculum-equivalent the student shall not be required to take additional core curriculum courses at the receiving public institution.

If a student does not complete all of the approved core curriculum-equivalent courses offered, the receiving public institution must award the student academic credit for each course that the student successfully completed, however, the student may be required to satisfy further course requirements in the core curriculum.
