HB 1019 -- AVIATION INSURANCE

Currently, insurers must file with the Director of the Missouri Department of Commerce and Insurance, except for commercial property or commercial casualty insurance, every manual of classifications, rules, underwriting rules and rates, every rating plan and every modification of the foregoing which it uses and the policies and forms to which such rates are applied.

Insurance against loss of or damage to an aircraft is currently exempt from the rate plan filing requirements.

This bill adds insurance against liability, other than employer's liability, arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of aircraft to the exemption.
