

HB 2310 -- TRANSFERABLE CREDIT FROM COMMUNITY COLLEGES

SPONSOR: Parker

This bill increases from 42 to 60 the number of semester credit hours that shall be approved as "transferable core of lower-division courses" from community colleges and four-year universities. By the 2025-26 academic year the coordinating board for higher education shall identify an additional 18 credit hours to be included in the transferable core of lower-division courses.

The bill allows students with an associate degree from a Missouri public institution of higher education to be considered as satisfying the transferable lower-division coursework requirements and upon transfer to a public institution no additional general education requirements for the same program of study will be required.
