§565.030 – Trial procedures

In response to similar legislation from 2023, HB 694, officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** stated there may be some impact but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Officials from the Attorney General's Office, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Department of Corrections, the Office of the Governor, and the Office of the State Public Defender each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
