ASSUMPTION

§41.201 – Missouri National Guard members

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri National Guard** and the **Department of Revenue** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to similar legislation from 2021 (SB 258), officials from the **Office of Administration** stated this bill would appear to have no fiscal impact, because under RSMo 105.711.2(2) "members of the Missouri National Guard upon conduct of such officer or employee arising out of and performed in connection with his or her official duties on behalf of the state" are covered under the Legal Expense Fund. Therefore, it is anticipated that there will be no fiscal impact to the Legal Expense Fund (LEF).

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.
