

HB 436 -- BREAST CANCER AWARENESS DAY

SPONSOR: Nickson-Clark

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Tourism by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill designates October 2nd of each year as "Breast Cancer Awareness Day", the most commonly occurring cancer among women in the United States.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that this would help raise awareness and hopefully help in the effort to find a cure for breast cancer.

Testifying in person for the bill was Representative Nickson-Clark.
