### AN ACT

To amend chapter 165, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school financial audits.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 165, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 165.125, to read as follows:

**165.125. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any time an audit examination of financial, transportation, and attendance records of a school district is conducted, there shall be included in such audit the following information relating to extracurricular activities within the district:**

- (1) Standard rent for facilities used;**
- (2) Salaries, benefits, and stipends for athletic directors;**
- (3) Salary stipends for coaches, sponsors, or faculty supervisors;**
- (4) Twenty percent of school administrator salaries;**
- (5) Equipment and uniform costs;**
- (6) Travel expenses and mileage;**
- (7) Dues or fees paid to any statewide organization that supervises extracurricular activities; and**
- (8) Costs associated with game officials, scorekeepers, or timekeepers.**

**The information required under subdivisions (1) to (8) of this subsection shall include numerical calculations representing expenditures under each subdivision for all extracurricular activities within a district and numerical calculations representing**

18 expenditures under each subdivision that are categorized by specific extracurricular  
19 activity.

20           **2. A public meeting shall be held to present the results of any audit examination**  
21 **performed, with time allocated for public comment. Notice of such meeting shall be**  
22 **published in the newspaper with the largest circulation within the municipality or county**  
23 **in which a school district is located at least two weeks prior to the meeting.**
