AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to state data centers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 37.870, to read as follows:

- 37.870. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the department of transportation, the department of conservation, the office of the state courts administrator, and the Missouri state highway patrol shall physically and operationally consolidate all existing and future data centers with the office of administration's data center facilities.
- 2. Each state agency listed in subsection 1 of this section may recommend, in writing, the minimum security standards for its respective data. The commissioner of administration, on the advice and counsel of the state chief information officer, may exceed such security standards based upon a balancing of potential threats to data loss, the geopolitical situation in the world as it regards security threats to this state and nation, and any additional factors deemed relevant to protect the data from loss.
- 3. Each state agency listed in subsection 1 of this section shall reimburse the office of administration for all costs associated with housing and providing data security.
- 4. The commissioner shall develop a cost allocation plan for the entire data center operation and shall fairly allocate the appropriate costs to each state agency with data in the data center. The cost allocation plan shall be in accordance with industry standards and practice for data center operations. The cost allocation plan shall be subject to chapter 610 unless the commissioner makes a determination that certain elements of the cost allocation plan may compromise the data's security. In that case, the commissioner may

redact certain elements of the cost allocation plan, but at a minimum, shall release the total costs allocated to each governmental entity.

- 5. The office of administration may provide data center services for any other political subdivision in the state of Missouri. The commissioner shall set a price for data center services independent of the cost allocation plan and shall operate these services as a for-profit model with the proceeds being deposited into the Missouri revolving information technology trust fund.
- 6. The office of administration may provide other computer related services or shared services to any other political subdivision in the state of Missouri. The commissioner shall set a price for such services independent of the cost allocation plan and shall operate these services as a for-profit model with the proceeds being deposited in the Missouri revolving information technology trust fund.
