AN ACT

To amend chapter 288, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to employment security.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 288, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 288.095, to read as follows:

288.095. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "employee" means a person
performing insured work for an employer required to make contributions under section
288.090.

2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, employees shall pay for
contributions through deductions from their wages. For each deduction, the employee
shall receive a statement showing the amount of the deduction and indicating that the
deduction was made for the purpose of supporting the unemployment compensation fund.
(2) The statement regarding the deduction shall appear on any document showing
the employee's wages for any period if a deduction described under this subsection was
made for that period.
