## AN ACT

To repeal section 214.160, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to cemetery trust funds.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 214.160, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 214.160, to read as follows:

214.160. The county commission shall invest or loan said trust fund or funds only in United States government, state, county or municipal bonds, certificates of deposit, first real estate mortgages, or deeds of trust. ~~[They]~~ **When sufficient, they** shall use the net income from said trust fund or funds or so much thereof as is necessary to support and maintain and beautify any public or private cemetery or any particular part thereof which may be designated by the person, persons or firm or association making said gift or bequest. **If the net income from said trust fund or funds is not sufficient to support and maintain and beautify a cemetery, then the commission shall use as much of the principal thereof as the commission deems necessary for such purposes.** In maintaining or supporting the cemetery or any particular part or portion thereof the commission shall as nearly as possible follow the expressed wishes of the creator of said trust fund.
