AN ACT

To repeal section 571.126, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to concealed carry endorsements and permits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 571.126, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 571.126, to read as follows:

571.126. 1. Notwithstanding any other state law to the contrary, no state agency shall disclose to the federal government the statewide list of persons who have obtained a concealed carry endorsement or permit, including Missouri lifetime and extended concealed carry permits. Nothing in this section shall be construed to restrict access to individual records by any criminal justice agency authorized to access the Missouri uniform law enforcement system.

2. **No sheriff, as defined in subsection 13 of section 571.101, or any employee thereof, shall release the name or personal information of any individual who has been issued a concealed carry permit by such sheriff, including any lifetime or extended carry permit, except as required under subdivision (2) of subsection 9 of section 571.101.**
