## AN ACT

To amend chapter 229, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a landowner's failure to remove items from a roadway, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 229, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 229.152, to read as follows:

229.152. 1. No landowner shall fail to remove any obstruction or item including,

2 but not limited to, grass clippings, yard waste, or other hazardous material from a roadway

3 that could create a great risk of serious injury, death, or property damage to a motorist.

4 2. Any landowner who violates the provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall
5 be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
