AN ACT

To repeal section 161.102, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to high school physical education credits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 161.102, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 161.102, to read as follows:

161.102. 1. The state board of education shall:

(1) Adopt and promulgate rules and regulations deemed necessary to secure courses in physical education to all pupils and students in all public schools and in all educational institutions supported in whole or in part by the state; ~~and~~

(2) With the advice and cooperation of the director of the state department of health and senior services, compile and print a manual of physical education and health supervision and school nurse service to be distributed for use by the teachers, supervisors of physical education, school health supervisors, and school nurses of the state; **and**

(3) Adopt and promulgate rules necessary to allow a student's participation in a curricular show choir or marching band to satisfy physical education credits required for graduation from the student's high school.

2. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated under the authority of this chapter shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to the provisions of section 536.024.
