## AN ACT

To repeal sections $46.040,46.059,46.063$, and 46.075 , RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to counties, with a referendum clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:
Section A. Sections 46.040, 46.059, 46.063, and 46.075, RSMo, are repealed and three 2 new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 46.040, 46.048, and 46.059, to read 3 as follows:
46.040. This state is divided into one hundred [and fotrteen] twelve counties and one 2 city, by the names and designations following:

46.048. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, upon the consolidation 2 of any three counties, the most populous county shall assume all authorities, debts, 3 duties, liabilities, powers, responsibilities, and obligations of the less populous counties.
2. Upon voter approval of a consolidation of any three counties, the two less populous counties shall transfer title to all their assets and liabilities to the more populous county.
46.059. Beginning in the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River, [opposite the mouth of Moniteat Creek;] where a prolongation south of the range line between ranges six and seven, west, would intersect the same; thence up the middle of the main channel thereof to a point where the middle of the main channel of the Osage River intersects the same; thence up the middle of the main channel of the Osage River to the mouth of Profit's Creek; thence up said creek to the range line between ranges eleven and twelve; thence south with the said line to the southeast corner of township forty-two of range twelve; thence west with the township line between townships forty-one and forty-two to the middle of the main channel of the Osage River; thence up the same, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to a point where the township line between townships forty-one and forty-two crosses the same a second time; thence west with said line to the southwest corner of township forty-two, in range thirteen; thence north to the northwest corner of said township; thence west with the township line between townships forty-two and forty-three to the southwest corner of section thirty-two, in township forty-three, in range fourteen; thence in a direct line to the Missouri River, to a point where the subdivisional line between fractional sections twelve and thirteen, township forty-six, range fourteen, intersects the range line between ranges thirteen and fourteen; thence in a direct line to the nearest point in the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River; thence up said [creek] river, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to the line between townships forty-eight and forty-nine; thence in a direct line to the northeast corner of township fifty-one of range fourteen, west; thence east with the township line between townships fifty-one and fifty-two to the northeast corner of section two of township fifty-one of range eleven, west; thence south with the subdivisional lines to the southeast corner of section thirty-five of township fifty, range eleven, west; thence [west] east with the township lines between townships forty-nine and fifty to [the middle of the main fork of Cedar Creek, thenee down Cedar Creek, in the middle of the main ehannel thereof, to the most southern crossing of said ereek by the range line between ranges eleven and twelve;] the northeast corner of township forty-nine, range seven, west; thence south with the range line between ranges six and seven, west; thence south with said range line to the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River[; thence up said river, in the middle of the main channel thereof,] to the beginning.
[46.063. Beginning at a point in the middle of the main ehamel of the Missouri River, where a prolongation south of the range line between ranges six and seven, west, would interseet the same, thenee north with said range line to the northeast eomer of township forty-nine, range seven, west, thenee west with the township line between townships forty-nine and fifty to the main fork of Cedar Creek, thenee down said ereek, in the middle of the main ehannel thereof, to its southern interseetion with the range line between ranges eleven and twelve, thene south with said range line to the middle of the main ehanmel of the Missouri River, thenee down said river, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to the place of beginning.]
[46.075. Beginning at the southwest comer of section thirly-two, in township forty-three, in range fourteen; thenee in a direet line to the Missouri River, to a point where the subdivisional line between fractional seetions twelve and thirteen, township forty-six, range fourteen, interseets the range tine between ranges thinteen and fourteen, thence in a direet line to the nearest point in the middle of the main ehannel of the Missouri River, thence down the middle of the main ehannel thereof to a point where the middle of the main ehannel of the Osage River intersects the same, thence up the middle of the main ehanmel of the Osage River to the mouth of Profit's Creek, thenee up said ereek to the range line between ranges eleven and twelve, thenee south with the said line to the southeast corner of township forty-two of range twelve, thence west with the township line between townships forty-one and forty-two to the middle of the main ehannel of the Osage River, thenee up the same, in the middle of the main ehanmel thereof, to a point where the township line between townships forty-one and forty-two crosses the same a second time; thenee west with said line to the southwest eomer of township forty-two, in range thinteen, thenee north to the northwest comner of said township, thence west with the township line between townships forty-two and forty-three to the place of beginning.]

Section B. This act is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state for 2 approval or rejection at an election, which is hereby ordered and which shall be held and 3 conducted on the Tuesday immediately following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at 4 a special election to be called by the governor for that purpose, under the laws and 5 constitutional provisions of this state for the submission of referendum measures by the 6 general assembly. If approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon at such election and not 7 otherwise, the enactment of section 46.048 of this act shall become effective when approved,
8 the repeal and reenactment of sections 46.040 and 46.059 shall become effective on
9 November 1, 2022, and the repeal of sections 46.063 and 46.075 shall become effective on
10 November 1, 2022.
