AN ACT

To repeal sections 46.040, 46.059, 46.063, and 46.075, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to counties, with a referendum clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 46.040, 46.059, 46.063, and 46.075, RSMo, are repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 46.040, 46.048, and 46.059, to read as follows:

46.040. This state is divided into one hundred [and fourteen] twelve counties and one 2 city, by the names and designations following:

46.048. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, upon the consolidation

- 2 of any three counties, the most populous county shall assume all authorities, debts,
- 3 duties, liabilities, powers, responsibilities, and obligations of the less populous counties.

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2. Upon voter approval of a consolidation of any three counties, the two less
populous counties shall transfer title to all their assets and liabilities to the more
populous county.

46.059. Beginning in the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River, Jopposite the mouth of Moniteau Creek; where a prolongation south of the range line between 2 3 ranges six and seven, west, would intersect the same; thence up the middle of the main 4 channel thereof to a point where the middle of the main channel of the Osage River 5 intersects the same; thence up the middle of the main channel of the Osage River to the 6 mouth of Profit's Creek; thence up said creek to the range line between ranges eleven 7 and twelve; thence south with the said line to the southeast corner of township forty-two of range twelve; thence west with the township line between townships 8 9 forty-one and forty-two to the middle of the main channel of the Osage River; thence up the same, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to a point where the township line 10 between townships forty-one and forty-two crosses the same a second time; thence west 11 12 with said line to the southwest corner of township forty-two, in range thirteen; thence north to the northwest corner of said township; thence west with the township line 13 between townships forty-two and forty-three to the southwest corner of section 14 15 thirty-two, in township forty-three, in range fourteen; thence in a direct line to the 16 Missouri River, to a point where the subdivisional line between fractional sections twelve and thirteen, township forty-six, range fourteen, intersects the range line 17 between ranges thirteen and fourteen; thence in a direct line to the nearest point in the 18 middle of the main channel of the Missouri River; thence up said [creek] river, in the 19 20 middle of the main channel thereof, to the line between townships forty-eight and forty-nine; thence in a direct line to the northeast corner of township fifty-one of range 21 22 fourteen, west; thence east with the township line between townships fifty-one and fifty-two 23 to the northeast corner of section two of township fifty-one of range eleven, west; thence 24 south with the subdivisional lines to the southeast corner of section thirty-five of township 25 fifty, range eleven, west; thence [west] east with the township lines between townships 26 forty-nine and fifty to [the middle of the main fork of Cedar Creek; thence down Cedar 27 Creek, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to the most southern crossing of said creek 28 by the range line between ranges eleven and twelve: the northeast corner of township 29 forty-nine, range seven, west; thence south with the range line between ranges six and 30 seven, west; thence south with said range line to the middle of the main channel of the 31 Missouri River[; thence up said river, in the middle of the main channel thereof,] to the 32 beginning.

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[46.063. Beginning at a point in the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River, where a prolongation south of the range line between ranges six and seven, west, would intersect the same; thence north with said range line to the northeast corner of township forty-nine, range seven, west; thence west with the township line between townships forty-nine and fifty to the main fork of Cedar Creek; thence down said creek, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to its southern intersection with the range line between ranges eleven and twelve; thence south with said range line to the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River; thence down said river, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to the place of beginning.]

[46.075. Beginning at the southwest corner of section thirty-two, in township forty-three, in range fourteen; thence in a direct line to the Missouri 2 River, to a point where the subdivisional line between fractional sections 3 4 twelve and thirteen, township forty-six, range fourteen, intersects the range 5 line between ranges thirteen and fourteen; thence in a direct line to the nearest 6 point in the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River; thence down 7 the middle of the main channel thereof to a point where the middle of the main 8 channel of the Osage River intersects the same; thence up the middle of the 9 main channel of the Osage River to the mouth of Profit's Creek; thence up said creek to the range line between ranges eleven and twelve; thence south with 10 the said line to the southeast corner of township forty-two of range twelve: 11 12 thence west with the township line between townships forty-one and forty-two 13 to the middle of the main channel of the Osage River; thence up the same, in 14 the middle of the main channel thereof, to a point where the township line 15 between townships forty-one and forty-two crosses the same a second time; thence west with said line to the southwest corner of township forty-two, in 16 range thirteen; thence north to the northwest corner of said township; thence 17 18 west with the township line between townships forty-two and forty-three to the place of beginning.] 19

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Section B. This act is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state for approval or rejection at an election, which is hereby ordered and which shall be held and 2 conducted on the Tuesday immediately following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at 3 a special election to be called by the governor for that purpose, under the laws and 4 constitutional provisions of this state for the submission of referendum measures by the 5 6 general assembly. If approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon at such election and not otherwise, the enactment of section 46.048 of this act shall become effective when approved, 7 the repeal and reenactment of sections 46.040 and 46.059 shall become effective on 8 November 1, 2022, and the repeal of sections 46.063 and 46.075 shall become effective on 9 10 November 1, 2022.
