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**AN ACT**

To amend chapter 650, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the law enforcement terrorism prevention activity commission.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 650, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 650.580, to read as follows:

**650.580. 1. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:**

2 **(1) "Primary members", members of the law enforcement terrorism prevention**  
3 **activity commission who may cast a vote on matters before the law enforcement terrorism**  
4 **prevention activity commission;**

5 **(2) "Regions", the nine regions of the state designated by the Missouri state**  
6 **highway patrol;**

7 **(3) "Secondary members", members of the law enforcement terrorism prevention**  
8 **activity commission who may cast a vote on matters before the law enforcement terrorism**  
9 **prevention activity commission in the absence of the primary member.**

10 **2. There is hereby established within the department of public safety a "Law**  
11 **Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activity Commission", which shall consist of eighteen**  
12 **primary members and eighteen secondary members representing the nine regions of the**  
13 **state:**

14 **(1) The eighteen primary members of the commission shall consist of:**

15 **(a) Nine sheriffs, one from each region, selected by the Missouri Sheriffs'**  
16 **Association, who shall serve until replaced by the Missouri Sheriffs' Association; and**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

17           **(b) Nine chiefs of police, one from each region, selected by the Missouri Police**  
18 **Chiefs Association, who shall serve until replaced by the Missouri Police Chiefs Association;**

19           **(2) The eighteen secondary members of the commission shall consist of:**

20           **(a) Nine sheriffs, one from each region, selected by the Missouri Sheriffs'**  
21 **Association, who shall serve until replaced by the Missouri Sheriffs' Association; and**

22           **(b) Nine chiefs of police, one from each region, selected by the Missouri Police**  
23 **Chiefs Association, who shall serve until replaced by the Missouri Police Chiefs**  
24 **Association.**

25           **3. Both primary and secondary members of the law enforcement terrorism**  
26 **prevention activity commission shall annually elect a member to serve as chair. The law**  
27 **enforcement terrorism prevention activity commission shall meet at least twice a year at**  
28 **a time determined by the director of the department of public safety or by a majority vote**  
29 **of both primary and secondary members. Ten primary members of the law enforcement**  
30 **terrorism prevention activity commission shall constitute a quorum.**

31           **4. The names of the members of the law enforcement terrorism prevention activity**  
32 **commission shall be submitted to the director of the department of public safety for the**  
33 **sole purpose of acknowledgment of the members of the law enforcement terrorism**  
34 **prevention activity commission.**

35           **5. The law enforcement terrorism prevention activity commission shall make**  
36 **recommendations as to the appropriation of twenty-five percent of any grant the state**  
37 **receives from the United States Department of Homeland Security.**

38           **6. No member of the commission shall receive any compensation for the**  
39 **performance of his or her official duties but shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual**  
40 **and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his or her official duties.**

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
