AN ACT

To repeal section 208.646, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to health care for uninsured children.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 208.646, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 208.646, to read as follows:

208.646. There shall be [a thirty-day] no waiting period after [enrollment] receipt of an

- twenty-five percent of the federal poverty level before the child becomes eligible for insurance under the provisions of sections 208.631 to 208.658. If [the] a parent or guardian with an
- 5 income of more than two hundred twenty-five percent of the federal poverty level fails to meet
- 6 the co-payment on three separate occasions or premium requirements for three consecutive
- months, the child shall not be eligible for coverage under sections 208.631 to 208.658 for ninety
- days after the department provides notice of such failure to the parent or guardian.
