AN ACT

To repeal section 640.409, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to groundwater monitoring.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 640.409, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 640.409, to read as follows:

- 640.409. 1. The department shall establish, develop and maintain an ongoing statewide surface and groundwater monitoring program, the purposes of which are:
- 3 (1) Determination of ambient surface and groundwater quality for use as background 4 or baseline water quality data;
 - (2) Detection of trends in the character and concentration of contaminants in surface and groundwater resources; and
 - (3) Identification of areas highly vulnerable to contamination.
- 2. The department shall require groundwater monitoring at each permitted facility where there is a potential source of water contaminants or pollution including, but not limited to, a class IA, class IB, or class IC concentrated animal feeding operation, a mining operation, a power plant, and a golf course. Any rules and 12 regulations promulgated for the implementation and operation of this subsection shall 13 be designed to afford a prudent degree of environmental protection while 14 accommodating modern agricultural practices. A permitted facility described in this 15 subsection shall be strictly liable under section 644.051 for an unlawful discharge or

16 release of contaminants or pollutants into waters of the state.
