#### **AN ACT**

To appropriate money for real property leases, related services, utilities, systems furniture, structural modifications, and related expenses for the several departments of state government and the divisions and programs thereof to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, and to transfer money among certain funds for the period beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in Article

- 2 IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the purpose of funding each department,
- 3 division, agency, fund transfer and program described herein for the item or items stated, and
- 4 for no other purpose whatsoever chargeable to the fund designated for the period beginning July
- 5 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, as follows:

## PART 1

	Section 13.000. An appropriation may be comprised in whole or in part
2	of a one-time amount, and such one-time amount shall be
3	construed to be a component part of, and not in addition to, the
4	stated appropriation amount. Any amount of an appropriated
5	identified as "one-time" in this act shall not be considered an
6	addition to any ongoing core appropriation(s) in future fiscal
7	periods beyond June 30, 2024. Any amount identified as one-time
8	may, however, be requested in any future fiscal period as a new
9	decision item.
