AN ACT

To repeal section 589.426, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to sexual offender restrictions, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 589.426, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 589.426, to read as follows:

589.426. 1. Any person required to register as a sexual offender under sections 589.400

to 589.425 shall [be required] avoid all Halloween-related contact with children, and on
October thirty-first of each year [to]:

4 (1) [Avoid all Halloween-related contact with children;

5 (2)] Remain inside his or her residence between the hours of 5 p.m. and 10:30 p.m.
6 unless required to be elsewhere for just cause[,] including, but not limited to, employment or
7 medical emergencies;

8 [(3)] (2) Post a sign at his or her residence stating, "No candy or treats at this residence";

[(4)] (3) Leave all outside residential lighting off during the evening hours after 5 p.m.
2. Any person required to register as a sexual offender under sections 589.400 to 589.425

12 who violates the provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall be guilty of a class A 13 misdemeanor.
