AN ACT

To repeal section 188.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the Missouri right to life act.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 188.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 188.010, to read as follows:

188.010. **The provisions of this section shall be known and may be cited as the "Missouri Right to Life Act"**. It is the intention of the general assembly of the state of Missouri to ~~[grant]~~ **protect** the right to life ~~[to]~~ **of** all humans, born and unborn, and to ~~[regulate abortion to the full extent permitted by the Constitution of the United States, decisions of the United States Supreme Court, and federal statutes]~~ **require due process of law before the life of any human, born or unborn, is ended prior to natural death.**
