AN ACT

To amend chapter 162, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to federal funding of school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 162, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 162.932, to read as follows:

162.932. 1. Each school district that comprises a special school district located in any county of the third classification without a township form of government and with more than eighteen thousand but fewer than twenty thousand inhabitants and with a city of the third classification with more than six thousand but fewer than seven thousand inhabitants as the county seat and that receives or has received funds through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act of 2020, Pub. L. 116-136, shall pay such special school district a portion of its CARES Act funds in an amount specified in subsection 2 of this section.

2. The amount to be paid by each school district shall equal the product of the number of students educated by the special school district who reside in the school district multiplied by fifty percent of the quotient obtained by dividing the total amount of CARES Act funds received by the school district by the total number of students enrolled in the school district.

3. The provisions of this section shall apply only to the extent permitted by federal law.
