## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to officer-involved incidents.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 590.512, to read as follows:

590.512. 1. If an officer-involved death or an officer-involved shooting occurs, the officer involved in the incident shall take a drug test and undergo a psychiatric evaluation.

The law enforcement agency that employs the officer shall ensure that the requirements

- 2. For the purposes of this section, the following terms mean:
- (1) "Officer-involved death", the death of an individual that results directly from an action or omission by a law enforcement officer while the officer is on duty or while off duty but performing activities that are within the scope of the officer's law enforcement duties;
- (2) "Officer-involved shooting", an incident in which an individual is injured as a result of a law enforcement officer discharging the officer's firearm while on duty or while off duty but performing activities that are within the scope of the officer's law enforcement duties.
