### AN ACT

To amend chapter 476, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to limited access to certain court records.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 476, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 476.1020, to read as follows:

**476.1020. Any official court record pertaining to a case in which a person is charged with any offense reportable under section 43.506 or any ordinance violation shall not be made available to a member of the public through any state courts automated case management system. However, such official court record may be:**

(1) Made available to a member of the public through any state courts automated case management system if such member is physically present at a courthouse and the official court record is a record for that particular court; or

(2) Included in any state courts automated case management system accessible to the following persons:

(a) Court personnel;

(b) Law enforcement agencies;

(c) Judges;

(d) Prosecutors;

(e) A defendant's attorney; or

(f) Any other person needing access to such record if deemed necessary by the court.
