AN ACT

To amend chapter 292, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to COVID-19 vaccination.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 292, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 292.645, to read as follows:

292.645. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

- 2 (1) "Employee", any person performing work or service of any kind or 3 character for an employer;
 - (2) "Employer", any:
 - (a) Individual, sole proprietorship, partnership, limited liability company, corporation, or any other entity that is legally doing business in this state; or
- 7 **(b)** Department, agency, or instrumentality of the state or any political 8 subdivision of the state;
- 9 (3) "Political subdivision", any municipality, school district, special district, 0 local governmental body, county, city, town, or village.
 - 2. An employer shall not require an employee or prospective employee to undergo or prove receipt of a vaccination against COVID-19 as a condition of employment or continued employment.
- 3. An employee or prospective employee may bring a civil action in circuit court against an employer who violates the provisions of this section for such relief, including injunctive relief, as may be appropriate.
