## AN ACT

To amend chapter 26, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the Malcolm X day commission.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 26, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 26.755, to read as follows:

26.755. 1. **There is hereby created within the office of the governor the "Malcolm  
2 X Day Commission". The commission shall organize and coordinate activities and events  
3 in honor of Malcolm X, culminating with a festival-style event on the Saturday of or  
4 immediately prior to May nineteenth, the birthday of Malcolm X. Such events and  
5 activities shall be designed to celebrate the life of Malcolm X, raise awareness about his  
6 legacy in the civil rights movement, and encourage the end of violence, crime, substance  
7 abuse, and self-loathing that continue to cripple low-income urban communities.**

8 2. **The Malcolm X day commission shall consist of nine members to be appointed  
9 by the governor including, but not limited to, educators, civic and community leaders, and  
10 persons with a desire to keep Malcolm X's legacy alive. Members of the commission shall  
11 serve four-year terms; except that, of the first members appointed, three shall serve a term  
12 of two years, three shall serve a term of three years, and three shall serve a term of four  
13 years.**

14 3. **All members shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for all  
15 actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties as  
16 members of the commission.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

17           **4. The office of the governor shall provide funding, administrative support, and**  
18 **staff for the effective operation of the commission.**
