AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to wrongful conviction day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.391, to read as follows:

3 **9.391. October second each year is hereby designated as "Wrongful Conviction**
4 **Day" in Missouri. The citizens of this state are encouraged to participate in appropriate**
5 **events and activities to raise awareness about individuals who have been convicted of**
6 **crimes they did not commit and to focus on the causes of and remedies for wrongful**
7 **convictions, an issue that affects and devastates individuals, families, and societies**
8 **worldwide.**
