AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to vaccination requirements, with penalty provisions and an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 191.721, to read as follows:

191.721. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

- 2 (1) "COVID-19", the disease caused by the severe acute respiratory syndrome 3 coronavirus 2;
 - (2) "Entity", any:
 - (a) Sole proprietorship, partnership, limited liability company, corporation, or any other entity that is legally doing business in this state; or
- 7 **(b)** Department, agency, or instrumentality of the state or any political 8 subdivision of the state;
- 9 (3) "Political subdivision", any municipality, school district, special district, 0 local governmental body, county, city, town, or village.
- 2. An entity shall not require any person to undergo or prove receipt of a vaccination against COVID-19, influenza, or any other disease for which vaccination was not required by the entity before January 1, 2020, as a condition of:
 - (1) Employment or continued employment by the entity;
- 15 (2) Entry into any facility or venue controlled or owned by the entity;
- 16 (3) Service from the entity;
- 17 (4) Access to transportation systems or services provided by the entity; or

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

- 18 **(5)** Participation in any program, project, or event held or sponsored by the 19 entity.
- 20 3. Any violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to protect the right to decline

- 2 certain vaccinations, the enactment of section 191.721 of section A of this act is deemed
- 3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and
- 4 is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the
- 5 enactment of section 191.721 of section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its
- 6 passage and approval.
