## AN ACT

To repeal section 9.020, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to indigenous peoples' day.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 9.020, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof,  
2 to be known as section 9.020, to read as follows:

9.020. In each year the third Monday of January is known as "Martin Luther King Day"  
2 and the twelfth day of February is known as "Lincoln Day" and the thirteenth day of April is  
3 known as "Jefferson Day" and the second Monday in October is known as [~~Columbus Day~~]  
4 **"Indigenous Peoples' Day"**.
